



Conference/Workshop Oviedo, Spain 29 Feb.– 2 Mar. 2012



The EU Network DELTA-MIN, in association with EU Project CARB-FIX and the University of Oviedo announce a 3-day conference/workshop to be held at the University of Oviedo from February 29, 2012 on the general theme:

Mechanisms of Mineral Replacement Reactions

We welcome contributions for Oral and Poster sessions on any topics related to the themes of Delta-Min (www.Delta-Min.com) or Carb-Fix (www.or.is/Carbfix/). Mineral replacement reactions are involved in everything from metamorphism and metasomatism, weathering, ore deposits, carbon sequestration, waste containment etc... in fact all processes involving fluid-rock interaction.

The Conference will begin with an ice-breaker at ~7pm on Tuesday 28 February followed by 3 days of invited and contributed talks and posters, discussion times and evening social gatherings.

The Conference will be limited to a total of 100 participants, including the researchers from both EU projects and so applications to participate will be on a first-come first-served basis.

Young researchers can also apply for financial support towards travel and accommodation expenses. Applicants for funding (which is limited) will be selected based on details of their current research projects and brief CV.

The deadline for applications to participate in this meeting is 30 December 2011, after which further details of the meeting, abstract submission and plans for a special journal issue of selected papers will be circulated to registered participants.
